** Please note that 12 hrs/semester is needed for full-time status of all M.A. students per Wheaton College Catalog. Most M.A.-Clinical Psychology students take more than 12 credits in their Year 2 Fall Semester by taking Clinical Electives. Please meet with your adviser if you will plan on taking the minimum degree required courses (11 credits) for the Year 2 Fall Semester to discuss options for maintaining full-time status. In Year 2 Spring Semester, financial aid awards can be prorated. Please see your Financial Aid Counselor for details.
