



Tips for GRE Test Takers from the Graduate Admissions Office @ Wheaton College

Get Prepared with GRE® Test Prep Materials

Anyone who registers for a GRE® test or visits the GRE Web site at www.ets.org/gre has access to a wide range of test preparation materials. Test preparation materials include:

- **GRE® POWERPREP® Software**
This free software is sent to all computer-based General Test registrants. It can also be downloaded for free from the GRE Web site. It contains test tutorials, two computer-adaptive tests, test taking strategies, sample questions and explanations, and sample essays for the Analytical Writing Section.
- **GRE® Practice General Test**
ETS sends this free publication to all paper-based General Test registrants. It can also be downloaded for free from the GRE Web site. It contains a full-length paper-based General Test, answer key, score interpretive information, test taking strategies, sample questions and explanations, and sample essays for the Analytical Writing Section.
- **Sample General Test Questions**
Users can get immediate feedback on their answers to several sample GRE® Verbal and Quantitative test questions. The questions are organized by content category, and an explanation of the correct answer for each question is provided.
- **Math Review**
This free publication familiarizes students with the mathematical skills and concepts likely to be tested on the GRE General Test.
- **An Introduction to the Analytical Writing Section of the GRE® General Test**
Users get strategies for completing each task, scoring information, scoring guides, score level descriptions, a sample test, and essay responses with reader commentary.
- **GRE® Analytical Writing Information**
The GRE Web site contains the prepublished topics for the Analytical Writing measure, directions, scored sample essays, and scoring criteria.
- **GRE® Enhanced Diagnostic Service**
This Web-based service costs \$15. It provides immediate feedback on verbal and quantitative skill performance. Users can review descriptions of the skills tested and sample questions from the General Test. They can also answer questions and receive feedback on their performance on each question. The feedback includes the correct answers and rationales along with a comparison of their performance in each skill area with the performance of others who have taken the Verbal and Quantitative measures of the GRE General Test.

- **Practicing to Take the GRE General Test, 10th Edition**

This publication is available for \$21 (plus shipping). It contains Verbal and Quantitative Sections from seven paper-based General Tests, including one test with explanations. It also includes test-taking strategies, score conversion tables, and a math review for the Quantitative measure. The Analytical Writing Section contains two tests, sample questions, test-taking strategies, scoring criteria, sample essay responses, and reader commentary.

- **ScoreItNow!SM Online Writing Practice**

This online service costs \$10 for two essay submissions. It assists test takers in preparing for the Analytical Writing measure. Users can compose and submit essay responses online, get immediate scores on their responses to Analytical Writing tasks, and review sample essay responses and general suggestions for improving essay writing skills.

- **Subject Test Practice Books**

A Subject Test Practice Book is sent to each individual who registers for a Subject Test. The books can also be downloaded for free from the GRE Web site. Each book contains a full-length test and answer key, test taking strategies, and information to help users understand the scores they earned.
